EPA is adding 172 PFAS to list of toxic chemicals subject to reporting  
Also adding a reporting threshold of 100 lbs for each PFAS added to the list

- PFAS SNUR final rule published (no public comment)
- Bromopropane will be added to HAPs list

- EPA approved surface disinfectants tested against coronavirus –Lysol Disinfecting Spray and Lysol Disinfecting Max Cover Mist
